State park offers summer programs

Delaware Seashore State Park, adjacent to Route I between Dewey Beach and Bethany Beach, has a broad variety of programs designed to put participants in touch with the natural beauty of the ocean beaches and Inland Bays surrounding park lands.

The contact point for information on all programs and for reservations (where required) is the historic Indian River Life-Saving Station, located 1.5 miles north of Indian River Inlet, 227-6991.

Pontoon Boat Tours

Each Thursday through Aug. 24, two tours of Indian River Bay and Rehoboth Bay are conducted aboard a custom pontoon boat with capacity for 38 guests. Reservations are recommended.

The estuarine ecology tour, a scientific exploration of Indian River Bay, is conducted from 10 a.m. to noon each Thursday. Participants help with simple water testing and specimen col-

lection and discuss inland bay ecology. The fee for this "hands on" tour is \$15 per person.

A sightseeing tour is conducted from 1 to 2:30 p.m. each Thursday, and includes a short jaunt across the northern part of Indian River Bay and a large circlc in Rchoboth Bay.

On-board naturalists discuss estuarine and salt marsh ecology and help to identify egrets. ospreys, and other bird species and point out local landmarks on the shore.

The program fee for the sightseeing tour is \$10 per person.

Both trips depart from the Indian River Marina in Delaware Seashore State Park and participants should look for the Sand Dollar pontoon boat near the marina's office and snack bar. Drinking water and sunscreen are recommended. Pontoon tours are supported in part with a grant from the Center for Inland Bays.
